
TENT STAKES AND DIGGING HOLES



6" tent stakes only may be driven into the ground in all locations of the camping area. Permission must be received from the Services/Facilities Director, Vern Byrd, before any stake longer than 6" is driven into the ground because of the underground utilities that cross the property (Cam-Plex requirement). NO EXCEPTIONS! Once you have permission you MUST call 811, to have someone come to check for underground utilities before placing any stakes longer than 6". Failure to do this may be costly to you.

No digging holes or trenches in the campground or activity area is allowed at any time. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

BTP CAMPOREE SPEAKER



Pastor Damian Chandler was born in Toror Canada and raised on the island of Barbadc by his parents Michael and Grace Chandler His ministry journey started in a small churchoused in the basement of his home. With only 9 members, the burden of the ministry fell equally on the shoulders of all, including this 16-year-old teen. At night he could her the prayers of these humble people rising through the vents into his room. That small church made a large deposit into his spiritu hunger and stands as a turning point in his and a foundation for his call to ministry.

Realizing the need to add education to this passion, he began training for ministry in 19

at Oakwood College, in Huntsville, AL where he graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in Theology. He later furthered his preparation by pursuing and attaining a Master of Divin degree from the Adventist Theological Seminary of Andrews University, in Berrien Sprin Michigan.

In 2001 he was appointed Youth Pastor of Emerald City SDA Church in Seattle Washing where he founded Impact Youth Ministries, an urban youth ministry focused on develop teens with a contagious and fearless faith. He returned to Seattle in 2008 and was hono to take leadership at both the Maranatha and Love of Life churches. In 2011, he receive and accepted a call to return to Alabama, where he has been humbled to serve as the Associate Pastor of the Madison Mission SDA Church. On January 10th 2015, Damian v installed as the lead pastor of the Capitol City Seventh-day Adventist Church in Sacrame California.



BAPTISMAL CHALLENGE






MASTER GUIDE INVESTITURE

LETTER FROM THE MEDICAL TEAM

Dear Pathfinder Leaders & Staff,

The medical team is excited to be a part of another life-changing experience for our youth. We look forward to being of service to you and your Pathfinders. August 2024 is quickly approaching, and I am sure that you are diligently working to get everything ready for a successful experience. Your medical team has a few requests and expectations to ensure that we can provide optimum service to you and your Pathfinders.

Please read this letter carefully and work with your individual Pathfinders and Sponsors and share this information with them. Please provide the appropriate instruction and education needed to make this Camporee as safe as possible. The medical building will be staffed with doctors and nurses 24/7 as well as Paramedic/EMT teams that will be on golf carts roaming the grounds throughout the day and until after the evening program is completed and everyone is settled in for the night.

- We will have an ambulance on site during the camporee from 11:00 am to 11:00 pm and will dispatch from the medical building as needed.
- We will be working closely with local EMS to ensure that we are providing the best care possible in every situation.
- A medical team on a golf cart may lead the way and clear the way for the ambulance to get through. Instruct your club Pathfinders and sponsors to quickly move out of the way when they see/hear the ambulance and/or a golf cart responding to a scene.
- We do use air horns and sound them as this should alert that we are responding to an emergency
- Develop a system and process within your club and with surrounding clubs to provide directions to your site. Please be sure to have flashlights working and quickly available to direct us at night should we need to respond.
- Be aware of your surroundings and make sure that any "street markings" or other forms of direction are not removed and are easily visible.
- Please complete the attached medical information form for each person in your club adult & minors and others who are assisting with your club.
- Always carry your Pathfinder and adult sponsor medical information with you.
- Please do not ask for rides on the golf carts. We never know when we will need to respond quickly and we do not want anyone to get injured.
- Please come prepared for extreme temperatures hot AND cold.
- Please plan to purchase/bring or use available fresh water on the Camporee grounds so that each person in your club can drink at least 64 ounces/day.
- Please make sure that you plan meals to ensure that the members of your club are getting enough fiber and drinking enough water to avoid dehydration and constipation.

- It will save everyone a lot of time and avoid missing out on fun things if each club brings the following basic supplies:
 - Tylenol/Ibuprofen
 - Band-Aids (various sizes)
 - Ice packs (ones that turn cold once cracked)
 - Feminine hygiene supplies extra for those who are not prepared

WEAR COMFORTABLE SHOES

Know that everyone who attends will walk much more than most are used to. This is not a fashion show and sore feet will ruin the experience very quickly for those who are not prepared. Tennis shoes and socks are a must!!!

Please ensure that ALL members of your club (adults & Pathfinders) with special medical needs have ALL their medication and supplies and are packed to bring with them before leaving for Gillette:

- Epi pens
- Diabetic medication/supplies
- Asthma inhalers

HOSTING INTERNATIONAL CLUBS

Host clubs will be responsible in providing tents and food, at no cost, at their campsite from the evening of August 6 through the morning of August 11 (unless specific plans have been made with the guests to adjust the start and end time). Hosted guests will camp with their host group, within the North American Division area, organized by conferences within unions.

It is a good idea to be prepared for contingencies such as lost bedding/clothing during travel; improper clothing for weather changes (cold, rain, heat, wind); personal needs (toiletries, first aid, etc.), flashlights and batteries, or emergency cash needs.

As international group plans develop, you should communicate with your Guests to inquire how many Pathfinder girls and boys there will be, how many juniors or teens, and how many adult staff men or women will be coming, so you can plan accordingly.

It is the host club director's responsibility to keep your conference director informed about the number of guests you will be hosting to ensure adequate camping space is allotted to your club.
